#### **Agenda Item 4: Approval of the Institute's Annual Report**

#### **Agenda Item 5: Approval of the Appointment of the Auditors for 2026 and their Remuneration**

To approve the appointment of OditStandard LLP as the Auditors of the Institute for the year 2026 at a remuneration of MVR 30,000.

The Council of the Institute has approved the appointment of OditStandard LLP and requests the members' approval for the appointment of OditStandard LLP as the External Auditors of the Institute for the year 2026.

#### **2. Queries on AGM**

If a member has a query regarding any matter relating to the AGM, we ask members to email the queries to [members@camaldives.org](mailto:members@camaldives.org), no later than 1500 hrs on Friday, 12th June 2026, along with your full name and NIC number. The Institute will be accepting queries from members and proxy holders who are registered to attend the AGM.

#### **3. Members eligible to attend the AGM**

Persons registered as an Associate or Fellow Member of the Institute as of Friday, 12th June 2026 are eligible to attend and vote at the AGM.

#### **4. Registration**

Registration for AGM will be open for members starting from Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> May 2026. Eligible members are requested to register their attendance through the Institute's [member portal](#) by no later than 1500 hrs on Friday, 12th June 2026.

Members are required to ensure that their registration is complete before the given deadline.

Upon completing the registration, registered attendees will receive an email from the Institute confirming their registration for the AGM.



## **5. Proxy Registration**

A member who is entitled to attend and vote at the AGM can participate in-person or appoint 1 (one) proxy and vote in place of that member. The proxy holder must be over the age of 18, of sound mind, and able to vote on behalf of the member. The proxy holder can hold multiple proxies and vote on behalf of the proxies. The proxy need not be a member of the Institute.

The Institute may (but shall not be under any obligation) call members to verify the appointment of a proxy.

Members who wish to appoint a proxy to attend the AGM on their behalf may do so no later than 1500 hrs on Friday, 12th June 2026. The proxy registration option will be available in the member portal. Members are encouraged to ensure that the proxy information entered during registration is correct.

Member registrations and Proxy registrations which are incomplete, illegible, unclear or do not contain all the required information may be rejected at the discretion of the Institute.

Upon completing the registration, the member and proxy will receive an email from the Institute confirming the registration for the AGM.

## **6. Proxy Revocation**

Any member who has appointed a proxy can thereafter attend the AGM in person only if the proxy has been revoked. The appointed proxy can be revoked by submitting an email requesting for proxy revocation by no later than 1500 hrs on Friday, 12th June 2026. The request should be sent by e-mail to [members@camaldives.org](mailto:members@camaldives.org).

The Institute may (but shall not be under any obligation) to call members to verify the revocation of a proxy.

### **7. Participation at the AGM on Saturday, 13th June 2026**

Members and proxy holders are requested to attend Islamic University of Maldives King Fahd Building, Violet Magu, 12th June 2026, between 1600 – 1615 hrs and register at the registration table. The meeting will be starting exactly at 1615hrs.

### **8. General Information on Voting**

All members of the Institute as of Friday, 12th June 2026 are eligible to attend the AGM in person or by proxy and participate and vote in person or by proxy. Each member, whether attending in person or represented by proxy, is entitled to cast one vote per agenda item. Voting will be done by show of hand.

### **9. Dress Code**

Dress Code for the AGM will be smart casual attire.
